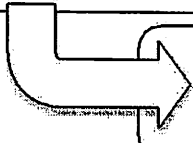
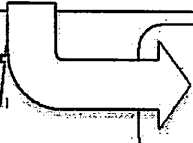


**What is a subject?** The subject of the sentence tells who or what the sentence is about. Example: The brown dog wagged its tail.



**What is a simple subject?** The simple subject is the most important word in the subject. Example: The brown dog wagged its tail.

**What is a predicate?** The predicate of the sentence tells what is or what happens. Example: The brown dog wagged its tail.

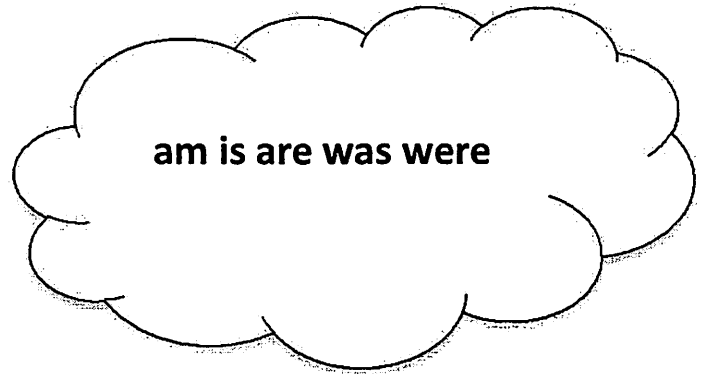


**What is a simple predicate?** The simple predicate is the verb at the beginning of the predicate. Example: The brown dog wagged its tail.

Names a person, place, thing, or idea

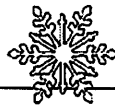
Example: mouse
